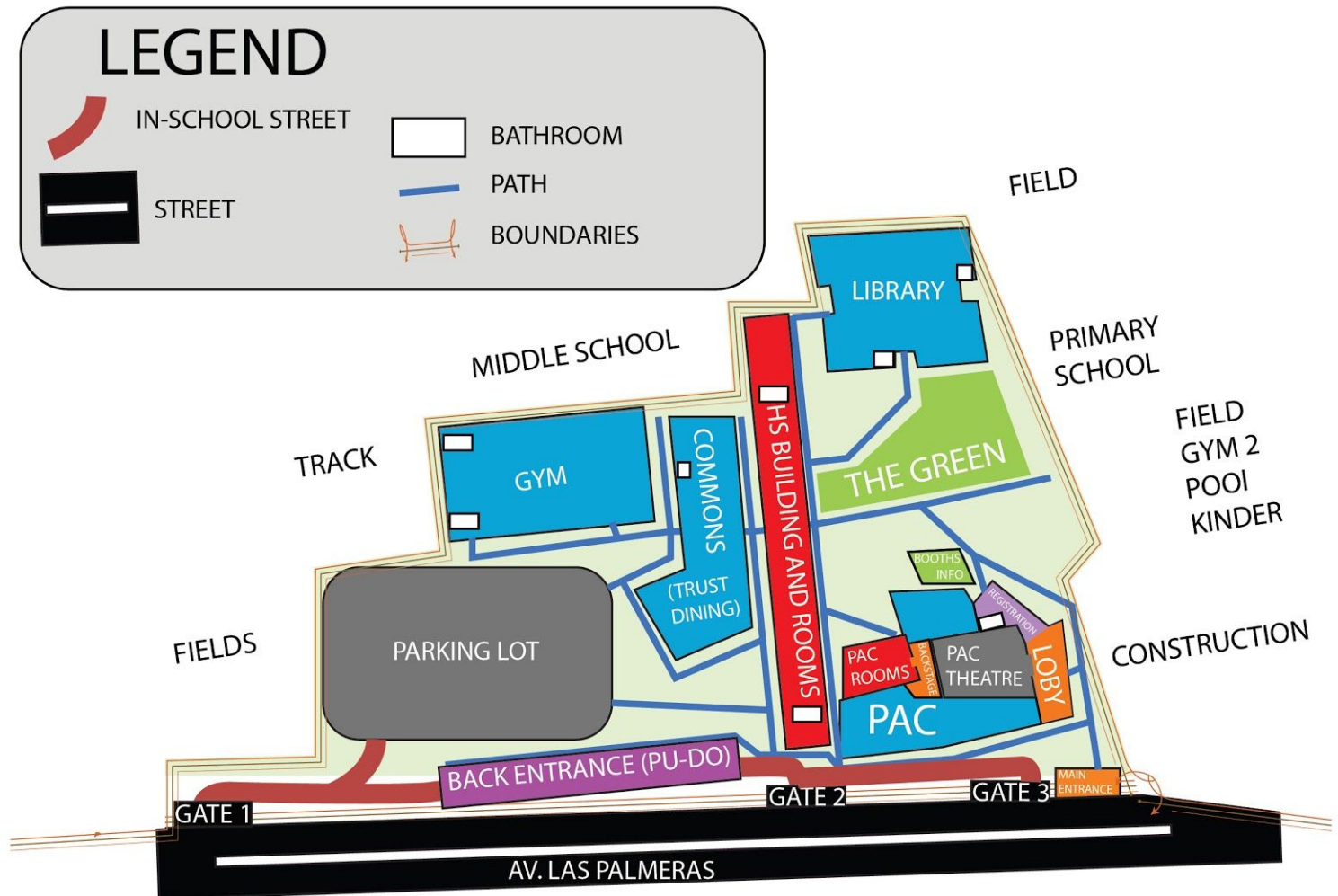

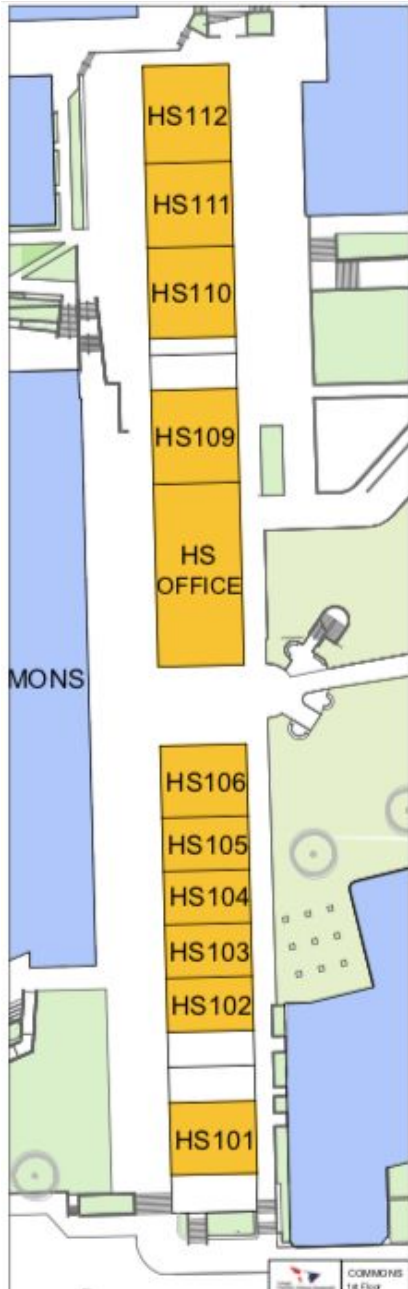


### INFORMATION:

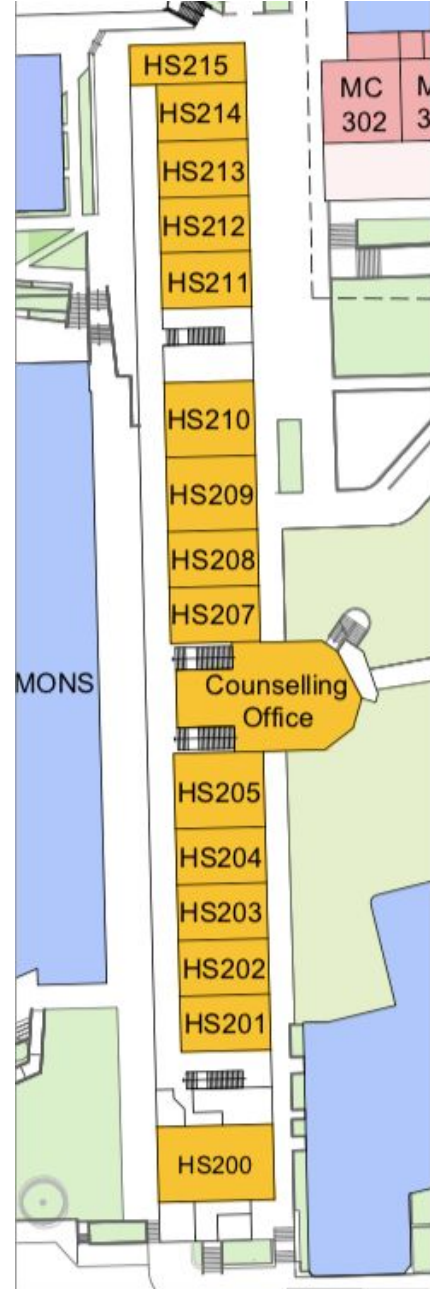
1. You will arrive and depart from the back entrance (Pick Up and Drop Off).

Your experience in the commons building will be confined mainly in the Trust Dining Hall where you will eat your meals and have fun!

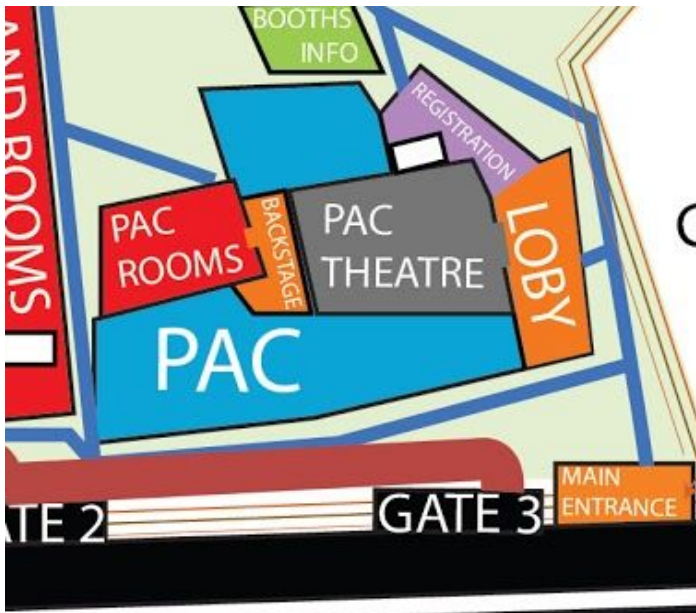
